ACTING PROJECT PROTOCOL

Introduction

Students will choose an acting performance of a feature film of their preference to reenact in front of their peers and turn in the fully formatted screenplay pages that contain the scene of said performance on *March 13, 2017*. This project has a 100 points value. Strict adherence to this protocol is required.

Format

The project will have both a written component and a performance.

- 1. The Scripted Part- has a value of 30 points. It consists of a clean printed sheet which follows the specific screenplay format used in the industry. This page(s) will contain the specific scene to be performed by the student.
- 2. The Performance- has a value of 70 points. Each student will perform a scripted part that should last no less than a minute. It is expected that each student will come fully prepared for this.
- 1. Script page(s) must be a professionally formatted (Courier New font, size 10, double spaced, etc.). Must be turned in a Manila folder with the student's name and homeroom number.
- 2. <u>All</u> NECESSARY TRAITS OF AN ACTOR will be observed for evaluation: Vocal Projection, Clarity of Speech, Physical Expressivity, Emotional Facility, Well Developed Imagination, Ability to interpret feelings, and Ability to Improvise.

Rules

- 3. The student's performance should be around one minute long.
- 4. The student's performance should have some type of conversation (dialogue or monologue).
- 5. Repetition of feature film for performances will not be allowed. It is suggested that students have alternate choices.
- 6. In keeping with proper societal standards; performances with nudity, language, sexual content, or strong violence are prohibited.

*IMPORTANT NOTICE

The only acceptable excuses for not delivering the project on the scheduled days are the illness of the student or an <u>immediate</u> family member, and <u>real</u> family emergencies in which case a medical or written parental excuse must be furnished in order to get the opportunity to give the project. Failure to meet these criteria will result in a zero (0) grade. The teacher reserves the right to reject frivolous excuses and/or attempts to circumvent this rule. Although "special" circumstances may arise, rules are meant to be followed, not broken.

Both students and parents must sign on the lines below as an acknowledgment and acceptance of the protocol.
